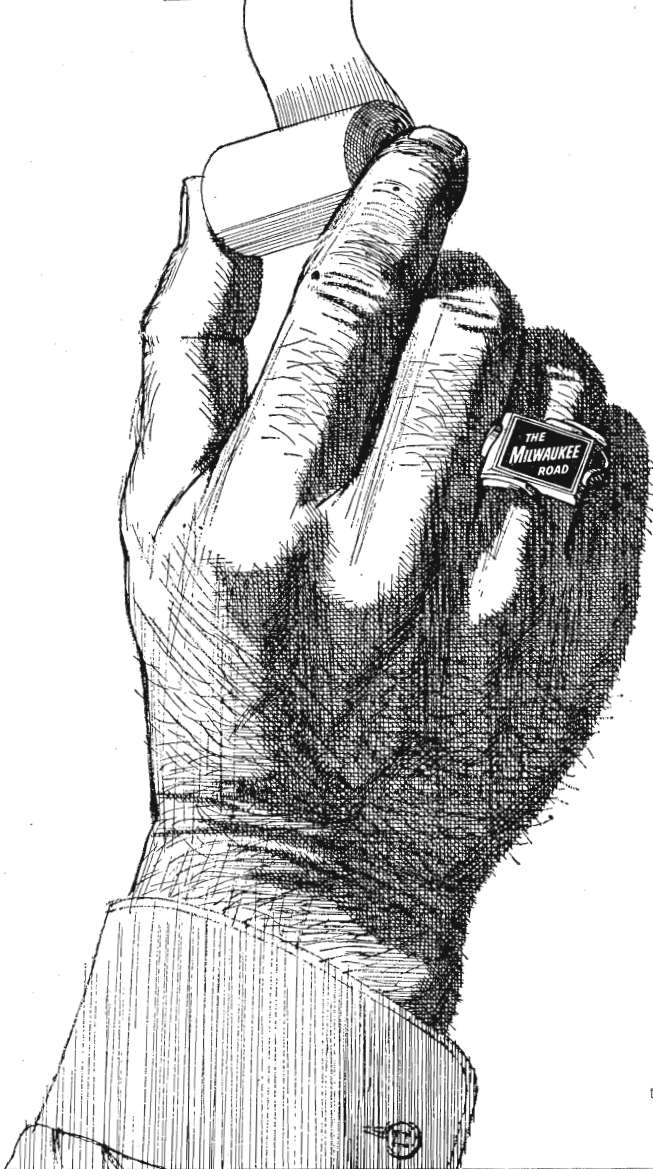
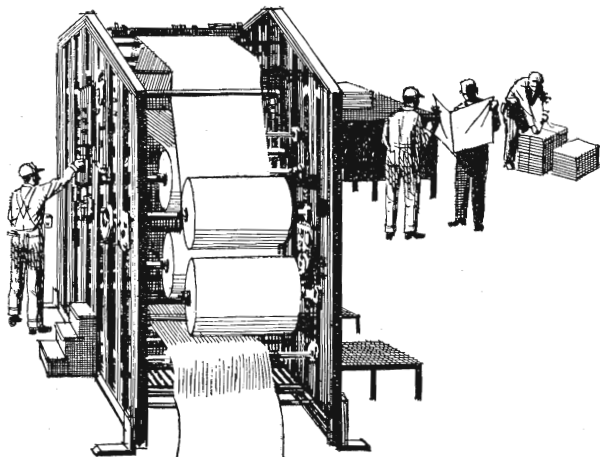

To help solve the problem, special procedures for handling cars in yards and terminals were introduced. In addition, a large number of existing 40' box cars were cut in half and 10' of length added in the middle. Extra-wide doors were also installed. This assures higher capacity, easier loading and unloading.
