CHICAGO, Nov. 2.-The Chicago. Milwaukee and St. Paul is again a member of the Western Passenger Association. About two years ago it withdrew from the association because three of the Chicago-St. Paul roads -the Chicago Great Western, the Wisconsin Central, and the Minneapolis and St. Louis-refused to join the association, and the Milwaukee and St. Paul claimed that its membership in the association prevented it from meeting the competition of these roads.
