RAILROAD MACHINISTS WIN.

Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul System Grants Advance in Wages.

CHICAGO, Sept. 13.—Five hundred machinists employed in the various shops of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul Reilroad system, have been granted an increase in wages averaging 30 cents a day.

The agreement was reaced to-day by General Superintendent Barr and General Manager Williams, in conference with a committee of machinists and D. W. Roderick, manager of the Associated Railroad Districts of the International Association of Machinists.
