## OHIOAGO, MILWAUKEE AND ST. PAUL.

MILWAUKEE, Wis., April 18.—The fifteenth annual report of the Chicago, Milwaukee and St. Paul Railway Company for the year ending Dec. 31, 1878, shows gross earnings of \$8,451,767, an increase of \$336,873 over 1877. The operating expenses, including taxes, were \$4,792,313, an increase of \$251,880. The entire cost of the company's property, including equipments, bridges, elevators, cattle-yards and grounds, is reported at \$59.772,244, which, after deducting certain assets, is an average of \$38,400 per mile for 1,512 miles of road owned.
