



Dear Sir:-

On my return from the East I find your letter of November 18th with reference to use of pole line between our power house and the Bitter Root Tunnel, providing you develop power above our dam on the Missoula River.

I remember that you did mention the matter when you were in Seattle, but it was in an informal way. I find, on considering the matter with our electrical engineers that such an arrangement would be undesirable, if not impracticable, and I hope you will see your way clear to waive that feature as we cannot agree to it. The prices we are paying we think are very liberal and sufficient to cover the full use of the property without any restrictions.
